The goal is to have the students assess the character of the 5 main characters in the movie (Tiana, The Shadow Man, Prince Naveen, Charlotte La Booff, & Lawrence).

DISCUSSION QUESTIONS

Prior to Watching the movie, ask the students to pay careful attention to the following 5 main characters:

Tiana
Prince Naveen
The Shadow Man
Charlotte LaBoof (Tiana's friend)
Lawrence (Prince Naveen's personal servant)

- 1) Identify the life goals of each of the 5 main characters?
- 2) Identify the life philosophies of each of the 5 main characters (in other words, how each plans to accomplish their life goals)?
- 3) On a scale of 1-10, rate the character of each of the 5 main characters? Explain your answer.
