



Switch sides if...

Equipment Required: An existing line on the ground or tape to make a line

Space Required: Small to medium

Group Size: Any

Skills: Confidence, Communication

Instructions: Start off by choosing one side of a line for all to stand on. Then ask everyone to “switch sides if” the statement you say applies to them.

Here are some example statements:

You prefer summer more than winter

You prefer dogs more than cats

You were born in (the state you live)...if you didn't switch sides tell someone where

You prefer spring more than fall

You have ridden a horse

You have lived in another state...if you switched sides tell someone where

You prefer pie more than cake

You have 4 or more siblings

You have a pet... if you switched sides tell someone what pet you have and it's name

You prefer morning more than night

You were named after someone...if you switched sides tell someone who

You like to sing

You prefer mountains more than beach

You prefer books more than movies

Play an instrument...if you switched sides tell someone what instrument you play

You like to play sports or have played on any teams

You prefer dark chocolate more than milk chocolate

Discussion points:

- 1) Did you learn more about your teammates?
- 2) Do you have more stuff in common then you thought?
- 3) What did you take away from this task?
